

SIC JEOPARDY

OR

A SURVEYOR'S GAME OF JEOPARDY

SCOPE: This workshop is a pattered after the TV show of the same name. A Master of Ceremonies will ask three groups of three surveyors questions patterned after survey principles. History, historical subjects, maps and mapping, instrumentation, law, minimum standards and various other areas that surveyors usually encounter.

OUTLINE OF PRESENTATION

- I. Group one of three surveyors are tested with one surveyor emerging as winner.
The winner is presented with a nominal prize.
- II. The process is repeated for a total of three questionings.
- III. The winner of each session advances to the Final Traverse, where each surveyor places his bet on the final question. The winner of the Final Question is presented with a suitable prize,
- IV. Each question is monitored by three judges who will adjudicate the answers for their correctness.

On registration each registrant or potential contestant is asked if they wish to be considered as being a contestant, with the final nine individuals being selected by draw.
